RESEARCHER AGREEMENT CONDITIONAL TO ACCESS OF THE
PAPERS OF U.S. REPRESENTATIVE DENNIS MOORE

In donating his congressional papers to the University of Kansas, Congressman Dennis Moore has established certain conditions that must be agreed to before access to the collection is permitted. The intent of the conditions is to make this collection available to the public as quickly as possible, while protecting the privacy rights of living individuals who have corresponded with the Congressman and his staff and any information about foreign relations of the United States that might affect the security of the United States. The conditions for use of the collection are as follows:

- A. Information in these papers and other historical materials will not be used in a way which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of the personal privacy or libel of a living person.
- B. Information relating to investigations of individuals for proposed appointments to office or to other personal matters directly affecting individual privacy will not be disclosed.
- C. The researcher shall maintain the confidentiality of the identity of any individual person who corresponded with the Congressman or his office to seek casework assistance and/or to express his or her opinion.
- D. Any lists of individual names and addresses found in the records, in whatever format, may not be used for any purpose or provided to other parties.

I agree to abide by the conditions listed above. I understand that, in accordance with the agreement between Congressman Dennis Moore and the University of Kansas, any violation of these conditions may result in me being denied current or future access to the collection.
