George M. Beal (Professor Emeritus of Architecture and Urban Design, University of Kansas) described himself and his wife (in a letter of June 1970 to Alexandra Mason) as "the first and possibly the only husband and wife "professor" combination to join the Taliesin Fellowship -- It was organized during 1932 and we arrived in early June 1934 to spend the summer. --"
